

New Programs

Associate of Arts in Political Science

The Associate of Arts Degree in Political Science is an Open Enrolment program. It is intended to prepare students to pursue third- and fourthyear courses at university as majors or minors in Political Science. The degree will also be beneficial for those students who wish to pursue careers in journalism, government, social policy, or law.

Citation: Access Langara

 This Limited Enrolment program is designed for students who are nonnative English speakers. It is a bridging program for students who wish to improve their English composition, comprehension, and study skills while simultaneously taking university studies courses.

- Bachelor of Business Administration Keyword search: BBA Admissions
- Nutrition Food Service Management Keyword search: Nutrition Food Admissions
- Internet and Web Technology Keyword search: Internet Web Admissions
- **Design Formation** Keyword search: Design Admissions
- Film Arts Keyword search: Film Admissions
- Theatre Arts Keyword search: Theatre Admissions



Bachelor of Business Administration (BBA)

- Successful completion of BC English 12, Communications 12 or equivalent will meet the English admission requirement
- No Math Requirement for Admission
- Students must meet all course prerequisite requirements for English and Math



Creative Arts Updated English Requirements

- Film Arts
- Theatre Arts at Studio 58
- Design Formation
- English requirement as follows:
 - LET 2
 - LPI 24 on essay with level 4
 - IELTS 6.5
 - TOEFL 550 (paper based) or 80 (IBT)
 - BC English 12 w/ 80% or higher in the final blended mark



Foundations of Health Studies

- High School students interested in pursuing the Bachelor's of Science in Nursing need to apply to the Foundations in Health Studies program
- Required Curriculum and Prerequisites:
 - ENGL 1127 English 12 (80% or higher in final blended mark)
 - BIOL 1190 English 12 (C+ minimum) and either Biology 11 (C+ minimum) or Biology 12 (C+ minimum). The high school Biology prerequisite needs to have been completed within the past 3 years.
 - STAT 1124: Principles of Math 11, Foundations of Math 11 or Pre-calculus 11 (C minimum), within the past 3 years.
 - Two additional university-transferrable electives.
- Prerequisites are listed on our website in the course descriptions for each course.

If students do not meet the high school prerequisites for the above mentioned courses, there are other options such as diagnostic tests or other Langara/post-secondary courses that you can take to upgrade if necessary.



Open Enrolment

- Previously known as Arts & Science
- Divided into individual program concentrations
- Entry requirements:
 - Graduation from BC High School or equivalent



SFU - Langara Dual Admission Program

Earn a Bachelor of Arts (BA) Degree or a Bachelor of Science (BSc) Degree from Simon Fraser University while studying at both Langara and SFU.

Admission requirements:

You must meet SFU's admission requirements for the Faculty of Arts and Social Sciences at SFU (BA) OR the Faculty of Science at SFU (BSc), OR the Faculty of Health Sciences (BA/BSc).

The SFU - Langara Degree Program allows you to move freely and easily between both institutions to complete the lower division requirements

This is not the same as transferring from Langara to SFU.



Open Enrolment

- Students who have been accepted to Open Enrolment programs have access to all university studies courses regardless of concentration as long as they meet the individual course prerequisites
- For students who apply to more than one program at time of application please advise them that the system will only allow them to accept one program
- Students can change their planned course of study at any time by filling out the Program Change Request Form (available online under Student Forms)
- It is <u>not</u> mandatory to select 3 programs at the time of application



Open Enrolment Credentials

- We offer 23 University Studies Diplomas
 - Diplomas are earned by completing a minimum of 60 credits in a specific area of study
- We offer 32 Associate Degrees
 - Two years of university-transferable credits (a minimum of 60 credits) in the arts, sciences, social science, business and humanities
 - We offer 3 University Studies Certificates
 - Approximately one year (minimum of 30-42 credits) in a specific area of study
 - We offer 5 University Studies Citations
 - A minimum of 12 credits in a specific area of study



Limited Enrolment Programs

- Admission requirements:
 - BC High School Graduation or equivalent ++
- We recommend any student applying to a Limited Enrolment program also choose a Open Enrolment program as a back up
- These programs are not designed as universitytransferable



Limited Enrolment Credentials

- We offer 4 Bachelors Degrees
 - Minimum of 120 credits in a specific area of study
- We offer 18 Career Studies Diplomas
 - Diplomas include a minimum of 60 credits in a specific area of study
- We offer 5 Certificates in Career Studies
 - Approximately one year (minimum of 30-42 credits) in a specific area of study
